The AP charged varies depending on the situation in the area when the ship calls there.

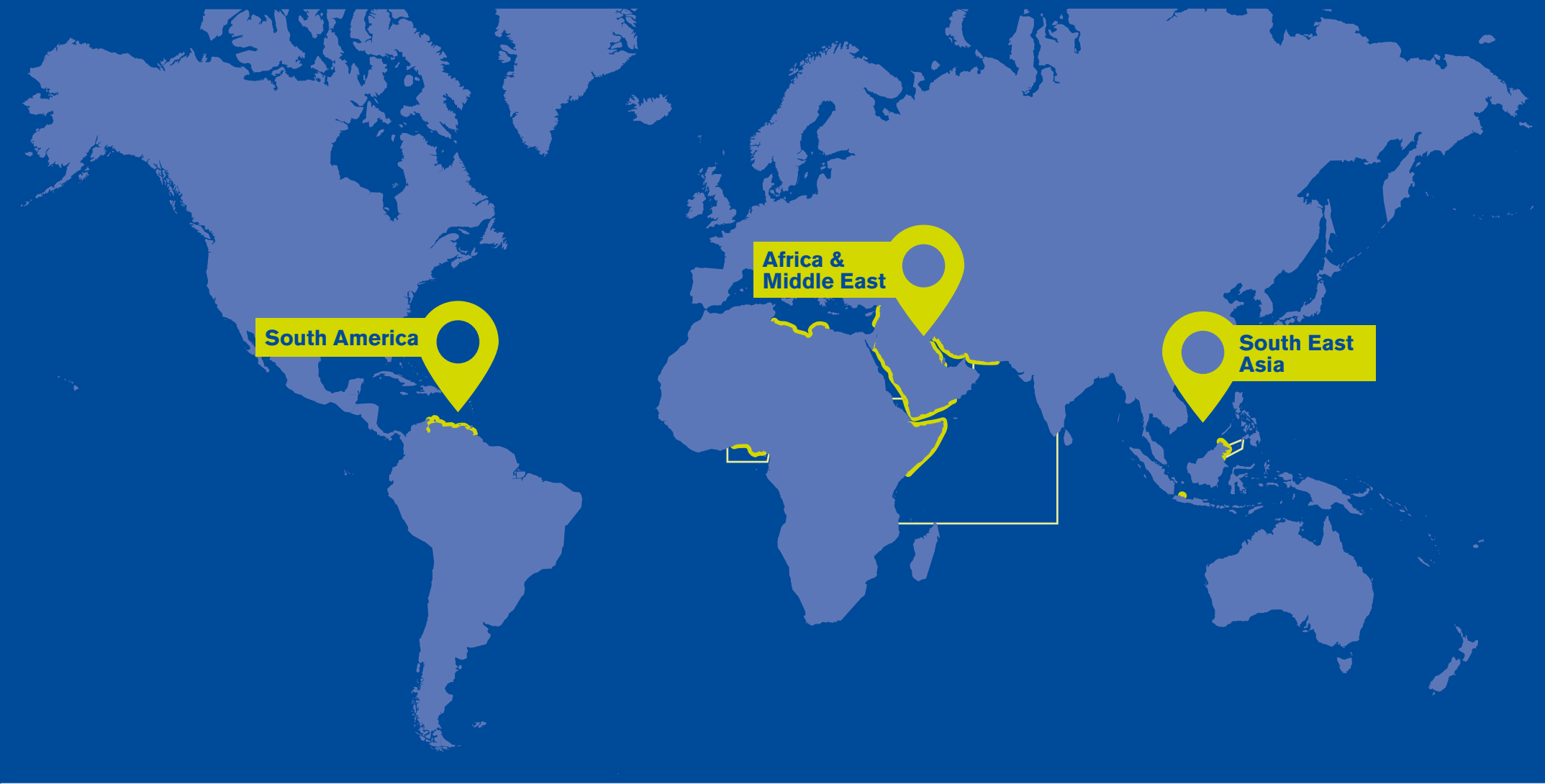
